



Securing Critical Information Infrastructures

Training Course – Network Documentation and Integration

Length – 8 Hours

Course Description

This course will take the class through the discovery and configuration of network devices to integrate them with the CS-MARS. The class can use their own CS-MARS with the actual network. Non-Cisco devices such as network servers and other monitored devices will be configured and added. Extended rule sets will also be created based on customer needs. Network attacks will be simulated to test the devices configuration, as well as the user's rule sets and event handling skills. The goal of this class is to fully integrate the CS-MARS into the customer network.

Course Outline

- Extensive network survey using CS-MARS
 - Configuration of existing network devices to integrate with the CS-MARS including routers, switches, firewalls, VPN, IPS/IDS, and other Cisco devices
 - Integration of non-Cisco devices including UNIX and Windows servers
 - Creation of extended rules sets using newly configured devices
 - Use of simulated network attacks to test rules and event notification
 - Event handling skills will demonstrated
